

## Road Map for Inclusive TVET and Employment *training*

### Background of SkYE Programme

Mott MacDonald Ltd is managing the 'Skills for Youth Employment in the Caribbean' (SkYE) programme for the UK Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO). The 'SkYE' programme is a 4-year programme from July 2018 – June 2022 which aims to develop a more productive, better trained, and inclusive workforce across 4 countries - St Vincent & the Grenadines, St Lucia, Dominica, and Grenada. The objective of the programme is to develop relevant market skills among young people (aged 15-30) to promote greater youth employment, greater productivity, and greater inclusiveness in the labour market, including better training and employment access for disadvantaged youth and people with disabilities. The programme is also intended to help improve the quality, reach and sustainability of technical and vocational education and training in the four focus countries.

### Objectives of this Initiative

SkYE is committed to working with young persons with disabilities (PWD) to secure their inclusion in education, training and enhance their opportunities for significant employment. SkYE is seeking to engage national training authorities, training providers and employers in a series of workshops divided into four modules that would lead participants:


- to an understanding of persons with disabilities
- to exploring your own perceptions and that of your respective agencies towards persons with disabilities
- developing a road map to inclusion for each of the three participating SkYE stakeholder group (NTAs/ Training Providers/ and Employers).

### Methodology

The workshop will comprise of four (4) modules and will be delivered online in the SkYE participating member states.

**Each module will be of a 2-hour duration and participants will be required to engage in additional readings and participate in group activities both during and after the sessions.**

**The training will commence the week beginning June 28<sup>th</sup> and will continue over 3 additional days ending mid - August**
